Employment Opportunity - Crossing Guard **in Hampton Borough**

The Borough of Hampton is seeking to hire Crossing Guards to assist the Hampton Borough School District. Description of duties: A 60 minute crossing post in the morning prior to school starting and a 60 minute crossing post in the afternoon when school concludes, only during school days. The pay will be \$20.00 per hour.

1. Crossing guards are appointed for a one (1) year period and that appointment may be revoked without cause or hearing. Crossing guards are part-time employees. No person shall be appointed as a Crossing Guard unless such person is sound in body, of good health and has not been convicted of any criminal offense involving moral turpitude.
2. During the hiring of Hampton Borough Crossing Guards, a preference will be given to Hampton Borough Residents.
3. Prior to appointment, a medical certification will be required as to your fitness for the position. This certification will be attached to the application.
4. Prior to appointment, a complete and thorough Background Investigation shall be conducted on all Crossing Guard applicants.

These are the basic physical requirements for the position including:

1. Ability to stand for between one and two hours at a time.
2. Ability to lift and hold in position a STOP paddle weighing approximately one pound while holding the opposite hand in an upright, raised position.
3. Ability to walk, unassisted, across street numerous times.
4. Ability to walk fast or run in emergency situation.
4. Ability to raise both feet to step over curb.
5. Ability to work in adverse weather conditions.
