Alan Brower, CPWM Director, Water Operator Matt Schafer – Deputy Director, Water Operator BRUSH CHIPPING: Brush chipping is for branches only, NOT for trees that have been removed. Cut ends should face the street. No Bamboo will be collected. No chipping in July or August. Brush chipping items should be out by the following dates: Wednesday September 6 & Wednesday, October 18.

LEAF PICK UP will begin on October 25 and End on December 8. If possible, please mulch your leaves. **GRASS CLIPPINGS: DO NOT PLACE GRASS CLIPPINGS IN THE STREET.**

TRASH will be collected every Monday **EXCEPT** when Monday is a holiday, then it will be collected on Tuesday. The sanitation limit is one (1) thirty-two gallon or two (2) twenty-gallon containers per household per week. "Extra Bag stickers" are available for purchase at the Borough Hall for \$3.00 per 25lbs.

RECYCLING will be collected every Tuesday unless **Monday is a holiday**, then it will be collected on Wednesday. **ALL recyclables may be mixed together. Cardboard should be tied. No container should weigh more than 50lbs. Please note that pizza boxes are trash not recycling.**

RECYCLE COACH APP – Download the Recycle Coach App on your phone as an easy way to find out how to dispose of your recyclables.

SNOW: Remove vehicles from the road at start of snow/ice storm. Snow/ice must be removed from sidewalks within 12 hours of precipitation ending.

Business and Rental Property Registration: Borough Ordinance No. 09-2022 was created due to The State of NJ, through Chapter 59, requiring all business owners and rental unit owners to have liability and to register with the Borough showing proof if the required insurance. Contact the Borough Clerk for further information.

Landlords/Tenants- All rental units must be registered with the Borough Clerk and inspected by the Rental Inspector Tom Carpenter 908-537-4521 each time a tenant moves out, prior to new tenant moving in.

Own Chickens? There is an Ordinance requiring chickens to be licensed. Please visit the Borough Website to view the Ordinance and obtain an application. ROOSTERS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE BOROUGH.
