Lithium Based (Li-ion, Ni-Cd, Ni-MH)	Tuesday Recycling
Televisions	Call DPW for number of "Extra Trash " Stickers needed for Pick Up Best Buy will take televisions as well.

Any business located in Hampton Borough that generates these, and/or other waste items not listed here that are recyclable should do so annually providing the Hampton Borough Recycling Coordinator with recycling tonnage information.
