**NAMING MAY 28 ROBERT P. GIBSON DAY**

**WHEREAS**, Robert P. Gibson was born in Hampton Borough on September 4, 1923; and

**WHEREAS**, Robert P. Gibson has resided in Hampton Borough his entire life; and

**WHEREAS**, at 18 years old he enlisted in the U.S. Army during World War II serving in Wales, England, France and Germany; and

**WHEREAS**, Robert was in the second wave of Allied soldiers who landed on the Normandy Beaches on June 6, 1944 the day known as D-Day; and

**WHEREAS**, six months later he fought in the Battle of the Bulge; and

**WHEREAS**, Robert served his Country in the US Army until 1945; and

**WHEREAS**, Robert P. Gibson served the Hampton Fire Company and is a Past Chief and life time member; and

**WHEREAS**, Robert P. Gibson honorably served as a Councilman in the Borough of Hampton from 1954-1965 and as Mayor from 1966-1971; and

**WHEREAS**, Robert is a Charter Member of the Glen Gardner Veterans of Foreign Wars;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Hampton recognize with gratitude Robert P. Gibson for his years of service to the Borough of Hampton, Hampton Fire Company and to his country, the great United States of America, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** that the 28<sup>th</sup> day of May be forever recognized as Robert P. Gibson Day in the Borough of Hampton.
